YEAR 10 REVISION SKILLS – PHASE ONE – TIME MANAGEMENT



In preparation for the imminent PPEs, the Raising Achievement team will be delivering revision skills sessions to the whole of Year 10. This will be done by House during tutor time as shown below. The first phase will be to set each student up with a flexible revision timetable. This will take into account their existing commitments as well as considering their academic needs (strengths and weaknesses) and ultimately each student will create a personalised timetable that works around them that they will bring home to use for the lead up to the PPEs and then ultimately for preparation for their GCSE exams. Phase Two will be to deliver sessions on "How to Revise" which will explore several revision styles with a view to each student trying out to ascertain which one suits their learning style best. DR BIKE - FREE BICYCLE CHECKS FOR FURZE PLATT STUDENTS



A representative from the charity Maidenhead Cycle Hub will be coming into school in June to carry out bike checks for students who regularly ride to school.

Students should meet outside the bike sheds at the start of the day. The bikes can be checked on site, throughout the day and collected at the end of the day, where students will be given an advisory note of work needing to be done to make the bike safe for riding.

You can also make independent arrangements to get the work completed through the Cycle Hub's website.

PRE-PUBLIC EXAMS – JUNE/JULY 2017



Year 10 Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) will take place from Friday 30th June to Friday 7th July. They take place during the normal school day, and students will be expected to be in lessons if they do not have an exam. As with previous years there is, therefore, no 'study leave' for PPEs and students will be in school from 8.45am to 3.15pm as usual.

However, when students have afternoon exams they will be permitted to leave after the exam finishes (with the exception of Business Studies on Tuesday 4^{th} , where students will be required to go back to their lesson). Please note that, while some exams will finish before 3.15pm, there are some subjects that will not finish until 3.30pm.

During the exams Year 10 will have their Break 2 at an earlier time than usual. This will run from 12.45am to 1.15pm. They will then start their afternoon exam after that.

Details of timings are on the letter below. Students will receive individual timetables which will have details of their seating and specific exam times.

Please may I ask you to work with your son/ daughter to ensure that they prepare appropriately for the PPEs. They should be following a revision timetable and working steadily and sustainably towards the exams. PPEs are essential preparation for the final GCSE examinations next summer.


