





HOME LEARNING TIMETABLES



Please can parents support their children with their home learning. Our home learning expectations are:

Years 7 and 8 follow fixed home learning timetables. Each piece of home learning should take 30 minutes, giving students between 1 hour and $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours of home learning per night.

Years 9-11 do not have a fixed home learning timetable, but will be set the following home learning. Each piece of home learning should take 1 hour, giving students an average of 2 hours of home learning per night:

English and Maths – 2 pieces per week

Science – 1 piece for each of the 3 sciences per week

Option subjects – 1 piece per week

Philosophy and Religion (Years 10 and 11) - 1 piece per week for those taking double or combined science; 1 piece per fortnight for those taking triple or separate sciences.
