






IMPORTANT INFORMATION

IMPORTANT DATES FOR YEAR 12 STUDENTS

We have a number of important dates and events coming up after half term for Year 12 students, so please be aware of the following information:

Pre Public Exams (PPEs):

- Monday 18th & Tuesday 19th June, Year 12 Art & Photography PPEs: Students to attend school at normal time. The exam duration is 5 hours with 2 breaks, and students will finish school as normal at 3.15pm.
- Monday 25th Thursday 28th June, Year 12 PPE period: During these 4 days, students will be on full exam/study leave and will not be expected to attend any school sessions (tutor time, assemblies, tutorials etc.) and will only be expected to attend their exams. All students must wear clothing that meets with the Sixth Form dress code whilst at school during this week. All students have an individual timetable issued to them outlining the times of their exams. Please note that the morning exams are due to start at 8.45am and students should arrive at 8.30am to be ready to start at 8.45am. Afternoon exams will start at 12.30pm and students should arrive at 12.15pm to be ready to start at 12.30pm.
