

FURZE PLATT SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE UPDATED SEPTEMBER 2018.

Furze Platt Senior School is a place of work. It has a long standing tradition and a place of respect in the local community. Our Sixth Form students have a special role in representing the school within the community and as an aspiration for younger students. They are, therefore, expected to dress accordingly. Those working in part-time jobs will know that a company like John Lewis would not expect male employees to go round with their shirts hanging out or female employees to have bare midriffs or blouses unbuttoned. The school expects a similar standard of dress.

LADIES

- A plain coloured tailored (fitted) suit, comprising of a fitted suit jacket and complementary skirt or dress or tailored (fitted) trousers.
(stretch lycra skirts, jeans and leggings are NOT permitted).
- Fitted shirt or blouse - plain colour with collar. They must be of a length that does not expose the midriff, particularly when reaching or stretching. Any camisoles worn underneath must be white.
- Footwear – dark colour leather shoes or smart ankle boots.
(sling-backs, flip-flops, canvas shoes, thick rubber soled shoes, casual boots or stilettos are NOT permitted).
- Plain tights – dark or natural colour.
- Cardigan or pullover (V-necked) – should only be seen, out of the classroom, under a jacket *(sweatshirts/round-necked/hooded pullovers are NOT permitted).*

Optional:

- Make up and jewellery in moderation, discreet in appearance.
- Plain coloured outdoor coat.

GENTLEMEN

- A plain coloured tailored (fitted) suit.
- A tie.
- Shirt – plain in colour. Shirts should always be tucked in.
- Footwear – dark colour leather shoes or smart ankle boots.
(trainers are NOT permitted).
- Socks – black, grey, blue or white.
- Pullover (V-necked) – plain colour
(sweatshirts/round-necked/hooded pullovers are NOT permitted).

Optional:

- Plain coloured outdoor coat.
