LEARNING AND ACHIEVEMENT

Work is carefully set to challenge all abilities and additional support is always available for those who find learning more difficult. Our academic achievements are impressive with young people progressing through our Sixth Form on to the most prestigious universities including Oxford and Cambridge. Examination results are very strong at all levels with performance significantly above the national averages. As well as achieving high grades at GCSE and A level, students also make outstanding progress and young people of all abilities make exceptional strides as they move through the school.

OUR CURRICULUM

We offer an enviable range of courses to suit students of all aptitudes. Our core offer is of course academic, but we also provide outstanding opportunities in the arts, computing, sport and technology. Additionally we provide vocational pathways for those who wish to pursue a more practical approach to their learning.

Great care is taken to ensure that students are mentored and guided to select the most appropriate courses at each stage of their school career. We make use of professional advisers, run an extensive careers and higher education fair and as they progress through the school students will make visits to universities and take part in work experience.

FACILITIES

We are very fortunate to have such a spacious and well equipped campus. There are extensive playing fields and many specialist facilities. Each department has its own suite of rooms allowing students to access the most appropriate and up to date resources for the subject. Access to ICT is central to the work of many departments so computer suites and mobile computing resources are found in abundance across our site. These provide the essential learning tools for a truly 21st century education.

THE ARTS

Cultural and artistic activities play an important role in enriching the life of the school. All students take part in music, drama, dance and art lessons during their first three years with us.

Music is very popular with many bands, orchestras, choirs and musical ensembles. There are regular concerts and smaller scale musical recitals. Our musicians regularly take part in local events and have toured abroad. More than 200 students benefit from additional instrumental and vocal lessons which are provided by visiting teachers. There is a digital recording studio and extensive practice facilities.

Drama and theatre events take place throughout the year in our purpose built drama studios. Performances range from presentations of classroom and examination drama to full scale musical productions. There are drama clubs for students of all ages. The school also stages presentations of dance and there is a highly acclaimed annual art exhibition. Visiting artists run workshops in a whole host of different visual media. Our students' work regularly wins prizes in local competitions.

SPORT

Sport is very important to us and through these activities students gain enormously.

Our sports teams are very successful and we compete in many local leagues in traditional sports, often winning district and county level competitions. The school also has several representatives in national level sports teams, most notably in athletics and rowing. Ex-students have recently gone on to represent their country at the Olympics and in professional international soccer.

Our sports facilities are second to none with ample playing fields, an all-weather pitch, multi-sports playing courts, a dance studio and a state of the art fitness suite. This excellent provision allows our young people to explore the full range of recreational and competitive sports activities and develop positive attitudes to their physical wellbeing.
