The government is currently consulting on its new education proposals. These include a proposal to return to selection at age 11 through the expansion of the grammar schools. Governors at Furze Platt are very concerned that the reintroduction of a grammar school in Maidenhead would have an impact on the strong comprehensive schools that serve the community currently. The consultation ends on 12th December 2016 and if you also feel strongly about this we would urge you to respond to the consultation by following the link below.
