The Pre-Public Exams (PPEs) will take place from Monday 26th February to Friday 9th March. They take place during the normal school day. Unlike in Years 10 and 11, where PPEs run as formal exams in the Sports Hall, Year 9 PPEs will take place in their normal classrooms during normal lesson times.

We wish him all the best for the Championships.




YEAR 9 FOOTBALL RESULTS

JULY END OF TERM CHANGE OF DATE

As you are probably aware, Furze Platt Senior School is part of the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead's secondary school expansion strategy. This is a very exciting opportunity. The local authority is investing over £7 million in expanding and improving our facilities.

However, it is now clear that in order to ensure safety and minimise disruption to teaching over the next 18 months, we will need to close the school one week early in the Summer Term. Therefore, the last day that students will be required to attend school will be Friday 13th July 2018. This decision has not been taken lightly and we apologise for any inconvenience.

BISHAM STUDENT SURVEY

Students in Bisham House will be participating in a survey run by a researcher from the Department of Psychology at Royal Holloway, University of London. The project involves investigating 13-18 year old's use of social networking sites (SNS) and the impacts of this use upon their social and emotional wellbeing. This research aims to explore access to SNS as well as perception of the risks and benefits of using SNS.
