The Highlight for me personally was the opening of the new teaching block and I am very much looking forward to the new hall being handed over to the school for fitting out later this month.

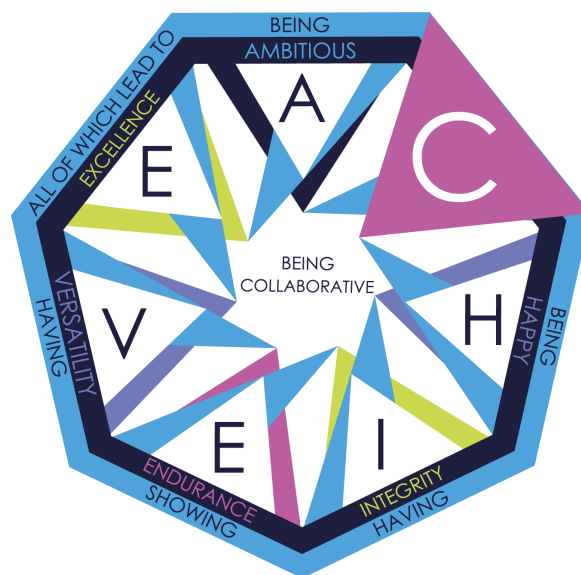

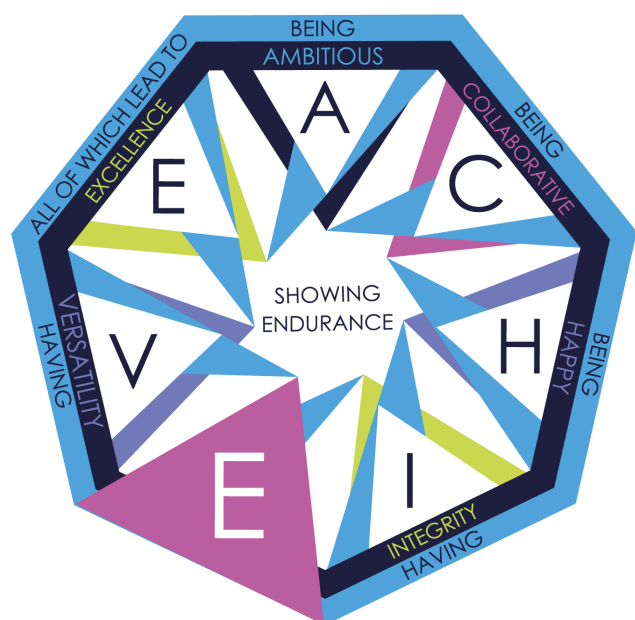

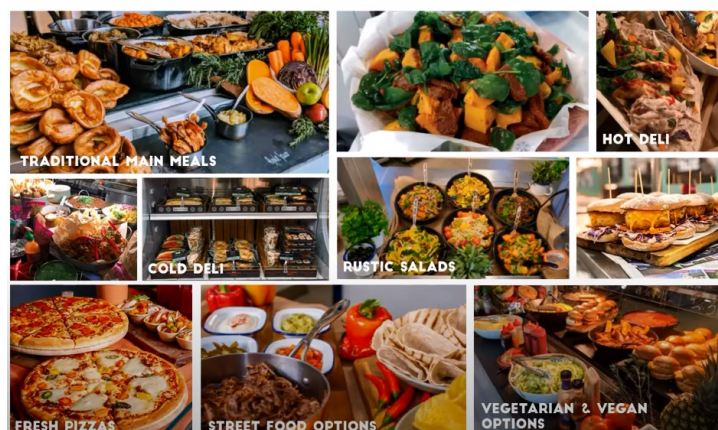

## MEDICAL REVIEW – SODIUM VALPROATE; PRIMODOS; MESH IMPLANTS

The Independent Medicines and Medical Devices Safety Review has recently published its report into three medical interventions, titled 'First Do No Harm'. The two year review covered three medical interventions - the epilepsy medication, sodium valproate; the hormone pregnancy test, Primodos; and pelvic mesh implants. Chaired by Baroness Julia Cumberlege CBE DL, who has been at the centre of healthcare policy for decades chairing national Reviews and acting as a Government spokesperson in the House of Lords, the report calls for many improvements to the healthcare system. These include a series of recommendations aimed at bringing about changes and to support those whose lives have been devastated by these interventions.

We are writing to keep you apprised of the recent government announcement that enables all children to return to school after the summer holidays.


The Royal Borough and local schools look forward to welcoming all your children back to school in September. Schools across the borough are working hard to update their risk assessments in order to ensure that all children will be able to start back in September safely.

The Department for Education guidance recognises that 'one size does not fit all', as has been the case with re-opening for some year groups in June. Schools will approach the reopening in different ways but please be assured that all of our schools will be opening and offering full time education to the children in our borough. This may involve staggered start and finish times and different starting dates as schools work out the best way to support the transition back into school and into different classes and year groups. Schools will communicate this specific information to you through their established channels.

The government announcement for schools to return in September has also resulted in school attendance to become mandatory once again with full curriculum and exams expected to take place in summer 2020/21. The best way to minimise the risks is to follow the advice and systems set out by your school on your return.

Schools will communicate any changes with you directly and we would encourage you to visit your school website and sign up to their social media groups, so you receive timely updates and news.
