


CRIMINOLOGY YEAR 13

With additional safety precautions we were still able to run our workshops for Criminology Year 13 students to help them understand Unit 3 of the course, i.e. Processing Forensic Evidence. Students had a chance to see some forensic equipment used while collecting and analysing the evidence. We analysed fibres and hair samples, and used various methods of identifying blood on a prop shirt. Well done to Suhayb, who volunteered to be dressed as a Scene of Crime Officer. Next week, we will continue our forensic unit looking at fingerprints, which will be another opportunity for students to do some practical work in a safe



manner. A big thank you to the Science Department for allowing us to use their classroom and equipment.






