MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER



Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

Our café staff went all out for Halloween with their fantastic displays of delicious treats and desserts to accompany the main meals of the day. Thank you to Debbie and all her staff.







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



This would minimise visitors to our Reception area.







Parent Support Adviser – To start asap

Part time, 32.5 Hours a week, start time 8.30am, finish time 3.30pm (includes a half hour unpaid break). Monday to Friday, term time only. Actual salary £17,700 - £19,100 pa depending on experience

We are looking for someone with experience of working with children, young people and their families to work with the students, parents and carers at Furze Platt Senior School, providing early intervention, support and guidance to improve outcomes for students.

Working under the guidance of our Assistant Headteacher (Pastoral), you would be an important point of contact with families identified as in need of support. You will establish and foster good relationships with students' parents and carers offering them advice and guidance to reinforce their self-esteem, thus helping them to support student achievements. The role will involve working with a range of external agencies, including health professionals and Children's Centres as well as signposting parents and carers to agencies and charities who can provide help. You would receive any necessary training to enable you to deliver Triple P (positive parenting) seminars, individual and group training for parents and carers and 1-1 and group ELSA (emotional literacy support) sessions with students. The role will require you to work with our well established and experienced pastoral support team to support students to interact and engage with activities and promote self-esteem and independence.

We are looking for someone who is able to work purposely and collaboratively with families, staff, agencies and charities to improve positive outcomes for disadvantaged students and their families. If you have good organisational and time management skills and are willing to work both as part of a team and independently this is an exciting opportunity to work at our school and benefit many or our students and their families.
