

**MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER**

Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year

Welcome to 2021! I hope that you had a good break and, despite everything, had the opportunity for some rest and relaxation over the break.



The Spring Term has not begun exactly as planned and I thank you all for your adaptability and patience as events have unfolded this week. We are now in a new National Lockdown with the vast majority of students learning online until February Half Term. I would like to thank you for all the positive and constructive comments we have had from parents and carers this week, as well as your support in ensuring our young people make the most of the online experience.

In the spirit of the first lockdown, I have again begun weekly video newsletters should you wish to hear some of our news and see our 'testing centre'. Please click on the link to do so.

Unlike the first lockdown, we have launched into the online lessons and already have answers to many of the questions. However, should you have any queries about things like Free School Meals, IT access, our support for Keyworker and Vulnerable students please do read the letter sent last Tuesday or access the resources on our website.

One area for which we do not yet have answers, is examinations. I have written to Year 11 and 13 students, parents and carers sharing what we know so far. We are now going to have a period of uncertainty as consultation occurs. We will, of course, share any news as soon as possible and are committed to helping our young people gain the best possible grades.

We started the week planning to test all students prior to their return to FPSS. This may still happen after half term, but in the meantime we have been able to train staff and set up our testing centre. We will be offering testing to all the keyworker and vulnerable students, as well as staff, onsite next week. As those of you who have had the test will know it is not the most pleasant experience but will likely be important in keeping FPSS as safe as possible.

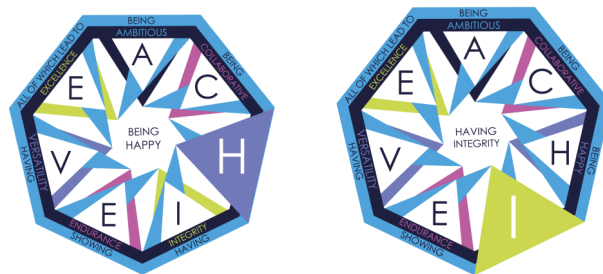

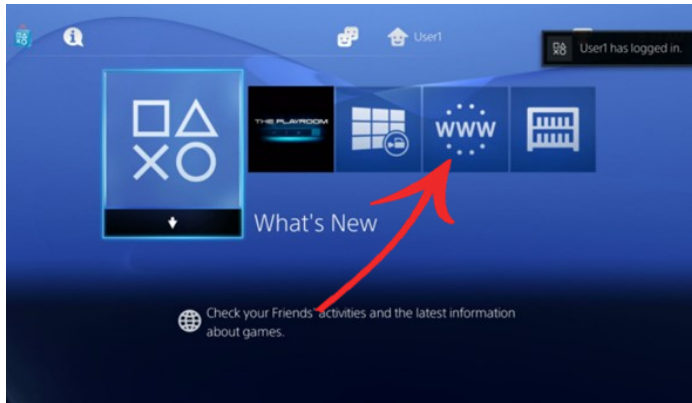
ACCESSING MICROSOFT TEAMS ON GAMES CONSOLES

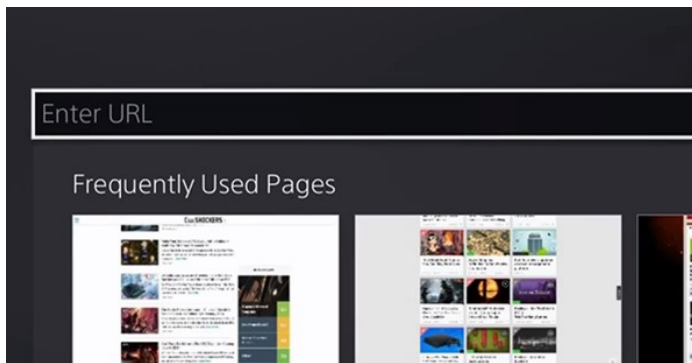


Accessing Microsoft Teams on PlayStation

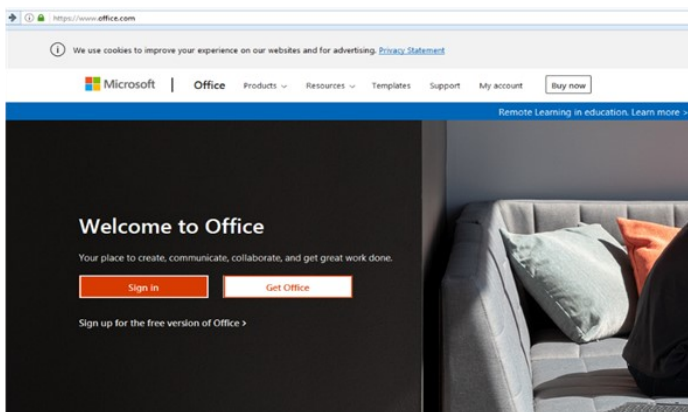
1) Go to 'www' on your homepage or in applications



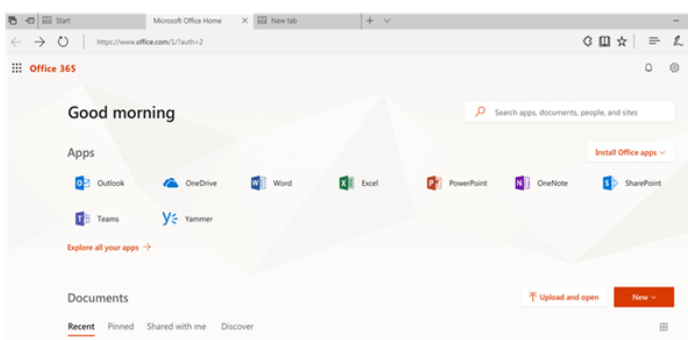
2) Type 'office.com' into the URL bar



3) Sign in to Office 365 with your own school email address

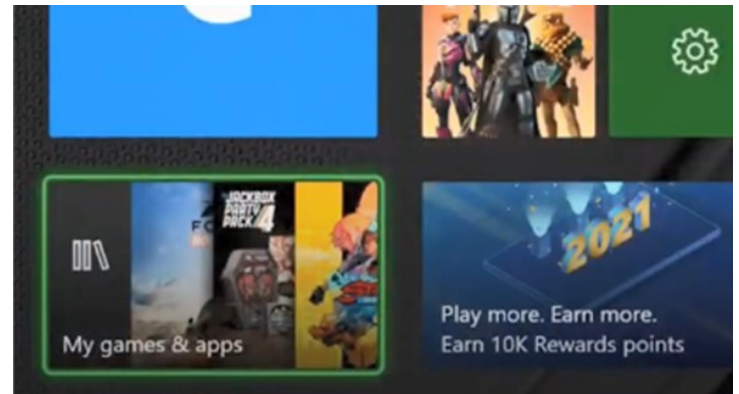


4) From your homepage you can access your Microsoft programmes

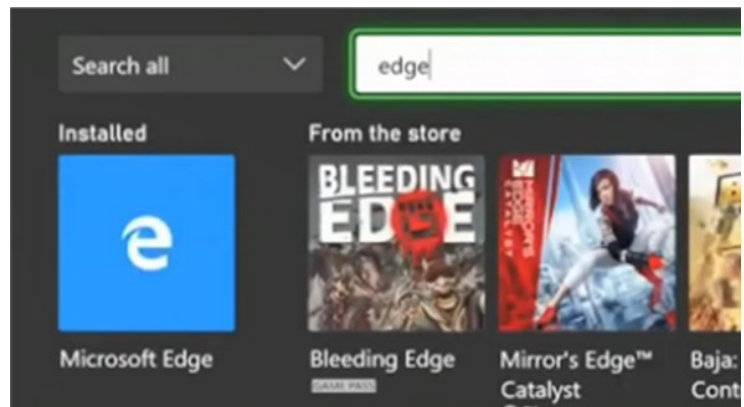


Accessing Microsoft Teams on Xbox

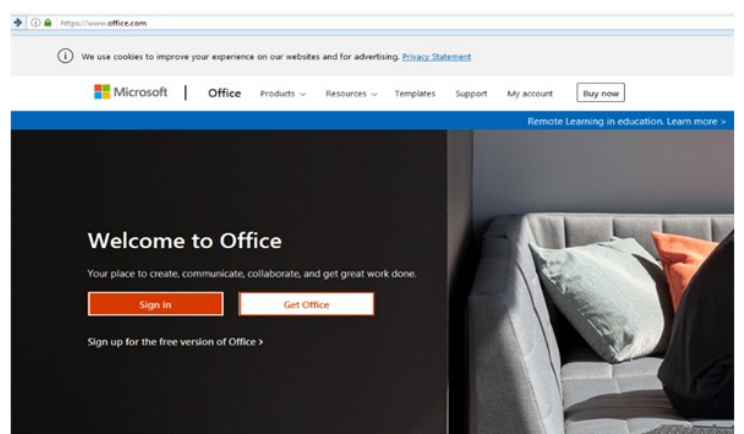
1) Go to 'My games & apps'



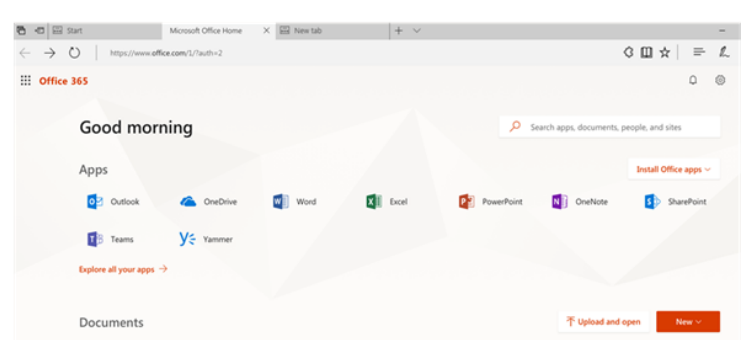
2) Search for 'Edge'

STRUGGLING WITH THE HIGH DEMAND OF STABLE INTERNET CONNECTIONS?

As we are now spending so much time at home, with an increased demand to be online for most of the day, this will increase the demand for stable internet coverage. If any of the following applies to your household, the school may be able to apply for you to get more data with your phone contract.

As a school we can request mobile data increases for children and young people who:

- do not have fixed broadband at home
- cannot afford additional data for their devices
- are experiencing disruption to their face-to-face education

Who can get help

Children with access to a mobile phone on one of the following networks might be able to benefit:

- Three
- Smarty
- Virgin Mobile
- EE
- Tesco Mobile
- Sky Mobile

Other providers may join the scheme at a later stage. Please be aware that each network have different lengths of time to wait while they process the requests.

If you are interested and the above applies to you, please contact fsm@furzeplatt.net with the following information (please be aware that we may need to check you are eligible for this):

- the name of the account holder
- the number of the mobile device
- the mobile network of that device (for example Three)

Once a network provider has processed a data increase, they'll send a text message to the account holder.
