Covid

Our day-to-day operations are now far closer to a prepandemic FPSS. However, precautions still exist including extra ventilation, enhanced cleaning regimes and encouraging hand sanitising (full details are in the Risk Assessment on our website). While masks are no longer compulsory, staff and students are welcome to continue to wear them and visitors to the school site are encouraged to do so (unless exempt).

We are also offering all students onsite tests. The first of these was this afternoon (Friday) and the second will be Tuesday. Students will then bring tests home so they can test twice a week at home during September. The aim of these is to stop the spread of coronavirus. 




INVITATIONS TO CLUBS
