## YEAR 10 TRAVEL AND TOURISM VISIT TO WINDSOR



The Year 10 Travel and Tourism students are currently studying the appeal of different tourist destinations so it was an ideal opportunity for them to go and visit a local tourist location.





Last Wednesday we took a trip to see just why Windsor is so popular to both domestic and inbound tourists. We walked through Alexander Gardens and saw the construction of Windsor on Ice, visited Windsor Castle and the Long Walk and finished off at the Windsor Royal Station. At each location, the students had to identify the different tourist attractions and facilities and make notes about them. Then they discussed which type of tourists the attractions would appeal to. For example, they felt the Windsor on Ice would appeal to families with young children, teenagers and couples on a weekend city break. It was a great way of reinforcing what they are learning in the classroom and will certainly benefit them when they come to write about their chosen destination for their assessment task.




