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### **INTRODUCTION TO ELSIE - AV1 ROBOT**

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Welcome to Elsie! Elsie is an AV1 robot who we will be using in some lessons with Year 8 so a student who is unable to be in school can access lessons with their teacher, and have some interaction with peers.



Image above shows the AV1 robot in the classroom setting.

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### How does it work?

AV1/Elsie sits in the classroom in place of the child, and the child can then join in lessons by listening, watching the teacher, asking questions, and participating in discussions. The child will be operating AV1/Elsie from a phone or tablet, wherever they might be undergoing treatment or recovering. The live streaming AV1 transmits a live stream, from the AV1 to the AV1 users' tablet. This means that no data is recorded. The live stream is end-to-end encrypted, meaning it is impossible for any external party to access the video or audio sent from the AV1/Elsie. It is not possible to record or screenshot when using the AV1 app on an Android device.

### Who can access the AV1?

Only one user can be connected to the AV1/Elsie at any time. Students will know the user is connected when the eyes light up. The AV1 user must enter a 4-digit code each time they wish to use their AV1. In addition, the AV1 user or their guardian are required to digitally accept terms and conditions, which state that only the AV1 user will be using the AV1.

These security features are in place to protect your child who will be in the same class as AV1/Elsie, as well as the child who is not able to attend school. Normal safeguarding procedures operated to keep your child safe in school will continue to be applied.

As the AV1/Elsie was introduced to us at school we were amazed by the capability and saw this as a fantastic opportunity for a student to learn from home, and for students to be part of such an interactive experience.

The Year 7 Boys football had a fantastic match against Altwood School winning 11-0! A special mention to Luke Wise who scored 4 goals and received player of the match








