This is to let you know exactly what they are, and enable you to be aware of the financial implications of some of these. Leavers' Hoodies - order by Monday 28th February

These should be ordered via your child's ParentMail account, indicating hoodie size and colour (plus nickname if required).

You can find the payment item by going to 'Payments' in the left-hand menu of ParentMail, and then clicking 'Shop' from the bottom menu.

Hoodies cost £25.00, are available in a range of sizes and colours and can be personalised with an acceptable nickname for an additional £5.00. Please note hoodies will be given out in May, exact date to follow.

Year 11 Graduation Ceremony - Wednesday 29th June

Our Year 11s will have a formal graduation ceremony, held at school, to mark the end of their compulsory schooling. Further details will follow in due course.

Year 11 Prom - Thursday 30th June

This will take place at Riverside Marquee, Maidenhead and tickets will cost approximately £35 per head, to include a buffet, disco, and photographs. There will be a professional photographer and photobooth at the event. Students will need to have collected a minimum of 1200 positive points (not overall points) to be able to purchase a ticket. Tickets will be on sale after the Easter holiday. Further details will follow in due course.

We would like to take this opportunity to wish your daughter/son well in their final weeks at school prior to their exams, and hope that the end of year celebrations will be a fitting end to a hardworking year. YEAR 10 CHILD DEVELOPMENT



Students were invited to take part in our Child Development Baby Simulator Program. This activity requires students to be the sole caretaker of the infant simulator, whose sounds and behaviour replicate those of a real infant. The experience is intended to demonstrate the full-time commitment required for parenting an infant including requiring care throughout the day and night.

Baby Simulation Program by Ruby-Jay Pickering

What did you enjoy about the experience?

I found it so fun and I really enjoyed it, I was really sad when it turned off. Believe it or not I actually loved doing the night feeds. I loved taking it to work with me. It was so entertaining to keep feeding it, changing his nappy, burping, rocking him etc.

What did you find hard?

I think trying to find out what he wanted and trying to do it quickly enough was really hard. And trying to remember the timings. And I found that changing him was really hard too because obviously it's a stiff doll and you have to hold its head and be really confident with it at the same time.

Do you think students should be doing this activity; is it useful and worthwhile?

I think it's a great opportunity for students to get a taste of life with a baby. I think it is very useful as it teaches you to hold the head and don't leave its side, we could also learn that having a baby will wake you up in the night and you do have to attend to it.

It also teaches us who to trust and who not to trust while holding your I believe it teaches us that feeding and burping, even cuddling your baby will take time and you have to be patient. Letting do students this experiment can teach them about life skills and if you are going out you still have to take your baby with you your because it is priority.




