Last week we were fortunate to have an onsite audit completed energy school across all our buildings. The auditor used equipment such as a thermal camera, thermometer and CO₂ meter to measure energy usage in all areas. A report and action plan will be drawn up to help the school manage, track and reduce electricity and gas usage

thereby saving money and reducing carbon emissions.

Students from the Eco Group were able to assist with the audit, using the thermal camera and taking measurements on equipment.

The energy audit is one of a number of measures the school is taking on our journey to net zero. Recent government funding will enable us to replace lighting with LED and we our working with MaidEnergy to install more solar panels on school roofs.




FURZE PLATT STUDENT'S COMPOSITION PREMIERE
