SUPPORT & CARE AT FURZE PLATT



Our students ACHIEVE more and better because of the support and care that surrounds them. Pastoral support at Furze Platt is based around our Tutoring system. All students and staff have a dedicated Tutor, Head of Progress and Pastoral Manager. This helps break our school into smaller groups where staff and students feel they belong and are supported.

Our House system creates identity and community helping students from all years get to know, help and care for each other.

Students participate in regular House challenges, from rowing to fitness, cooking to singing, spelling bees to countdown. These encourage students to develop leadership and interpersonal skills.

Core to our pastoral approach is our focus on good behaviour, building strong relationships and respect for fellow students, staff and all members of our community.

This is a kind and caring school. We do everything we can to ease transition from primary to secondary school. We meet Year 6 students and their teachers in their primary schools and we have transition days in July, along with an induction day in September.

IN THE CLASSROOM

Our curriculum is ambitious and broad to give students opportunities to develop both subject knowledge and interpersonal skills such as teamwork and communication. We understand teaching is about encouraging the desire to learn and seek new challenges within the classroom.

We are a fully inclusive comprehensive school with experienced teachers who plan lessons for students to enjoy, learn and flourish. Our teachers are subject specialists with knowledge and enthusiasm ensuring learning is interesting, current and varied using a wide range of teaching strategies to engage all students.

Teachers are experienced in differentiating work for students within their classroom setting, and making certain each student makes progress and feels supported in their learning. Our SEND students benefit from support provided by experienced teaching assistants to further help progress.

Teachers understand that good behaviour is key for good learning, and ensure positive behaviour is recognised within the classroom via a reward point system.

Each term there is a Celebration Event for the students who show an exceptional attitude to learning, we believe this is something that should be celebrated.

The positive respectful relationship that teachers build with students is part of our school ethos and present in every classroom. We recognise that things can go wrong, and we use a restorative approach to ensure the teacher/student can find a positive way forwards for learning.

Students' home learning is through an app from Class Charts which can be accessed by parents and students.

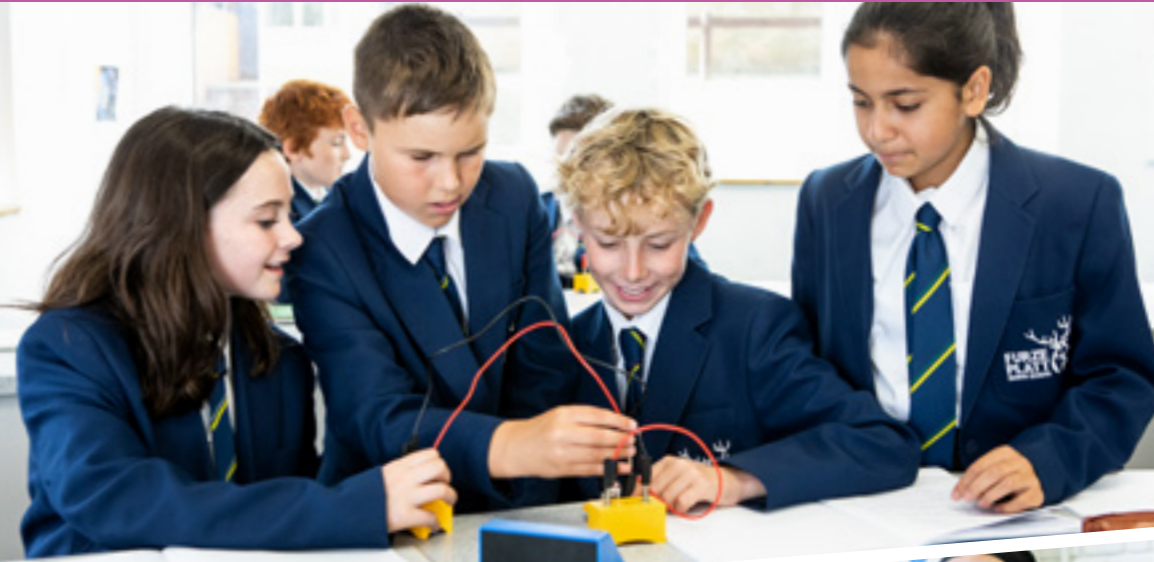

BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

For most Furze Platt students, the school day ends not at 3.15 but nearer 5pm. Each week, over 50 extra-curricular activities are on offer. These include an array of music groups, from choirs to percussion, from ukulele band to orchestras which culminate in concerts held throughout the year.

The quality of extra-curricular drama is similarly exceptional, with many after school performances for students of all years, plus the annual school musical. The school is rightly proud of its sporting success, with football, rugby, hockey and netball, athletics and tennis fixtures, while students benefit from the stunning Furze Platt Leisure Centre facilities.

Students can also attend one of the cooking and baking clubs or one of the subject-based revision classes.

The school runs a major programme of evening, day and residential trips in Britain and abroad. These include theatre visits, Geography and History fieldwork trips, and Biology and Geography research visits to Nettlecombe in Somerset. Furze Platt students also enjoy ski trips to the Alps and expeditions to Wales, Greece and Indonesia.

Additionally, the school runs a very successful Duke of Edinburgh programme in Years 9-13.

We know that students are more motivated and engaged in their studies when they have an excellent learning environment. Furze Platt students are fortunate to learn in high-quality facilities. This means teachers can offer even more stimulating lessons and offers students the chance to learn practically, as well as theoretically.

Our great facilities include: a purpose-built Maths block, state of the art Drama theatre and adjoining rehearsal studio, professional standard, floodlit Astro turf, three new, floodlit tennis / netball courts, and our enviable Furze Platt Leisure Centre, Sixth Form and the Music department with professional-standard recording studio. More recently we have added a new English department along with state-of-the-art Science laboratories and a new Theatre which stages performances and events for audience of over four hundred.

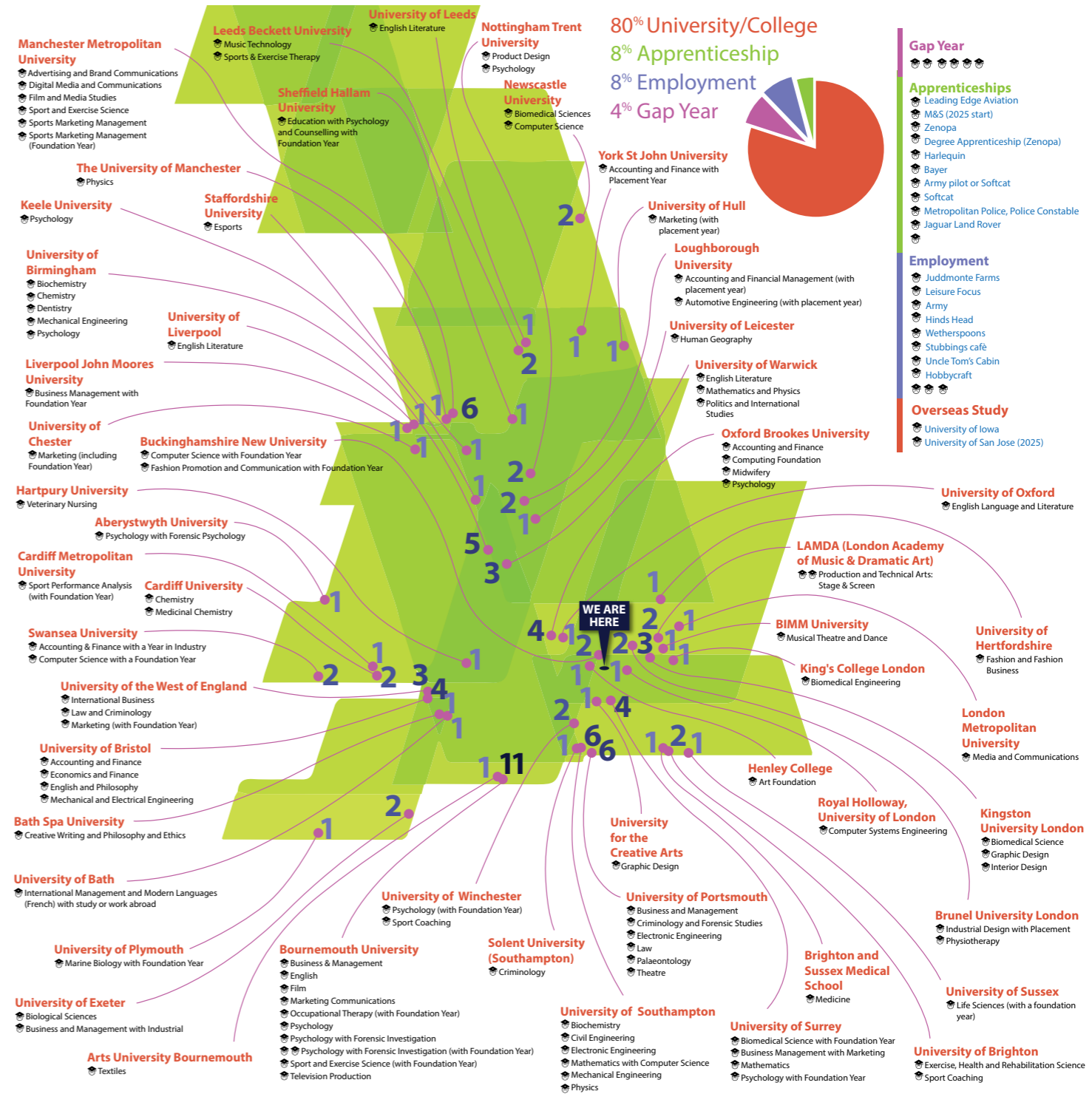
