ARRIVING AT AND LEAVING SCHOOL OUTSIDE NORMAL TIMES



Parent Accounts

Parents who wish to take a more active role in their children's home learning can achieve this by having their own Show My Homework / Satchel One account. It enables them to take a more proactive role in driving homework prioritisation, and keeping tabs on homework without having to be intrusive.

Parents sign-up for accounts directly with Show My Homework / Satchel One using student specific PIN codes issued by the school at the start of the academic year. Once setup, parents can login on the link below.






We also met a former student of Furze Platt and ex-Greenpower team member from the time the school dominated the event, Peter Hoare, who gave the students




