
Students were impressed by his honesty and bravery and haven't been shy in coming forward to thank him for it.

Congratulations to Demari Gumbs, Year 13, who will be competing in Germany for GB in the 400m (pb: 47.67) where he is currently ranked 4th in the country. He will be also doing the 400x4 Relay.

Demari has recently completed the two year Youth Talent Programme with England **Athletics** Talent Pathway. This course is designed to meet the needs of talented athletes, training with England coaches, to learn

how to build and develop relationships and how to analyse their performance against potential, compete at higher level competitions and how to talk to the media. Based at Brunel University, the course will provide Demari with a certificate in Level 3 Diploma in Sporting Excellence.


