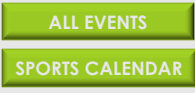
### Goodbye Year 13!

We have been partnering with Flooglebinder, a travel and conservation company, for the last three years. They are the first B-Corp certified travel company and are experts in delivering educational programmes that create positive change for both people and the planet.

During this exciting eight-day project, students will gain hands-on experience of turtle conservation. They will learn about turtle anatomy, the important role turtles play within ecosystems, and the conservation challenges they face. Students will also explore the impact of human activities on turtle populations, including the factors affecting their distribution and behaviour.

During this four-day adventure in South Wales, students will be immersed in all things wildlife, conservation and sustainability. The expedition is designed not only to develop environmental understanding but also to build teamwork, communication and personal development skills.

In line with the school's commitment to sustainable and environmentally responsible educational visits, we are confident that this trip will provide students with an unforgettable experience while ensuring minimal social and environmental impact on the local environment.

## FURZE PLATT ALUMNA REPRESENTING ENGLAND



Ex Furze Platt student and Plymouth Harriers Athlete Sarah Robbins has been selected to represent England at Four Nations Backyard Ultra Championship, marking a significant milestone in her rapidly rising ultra-running career. Sarah said she was proud and excited to have been selected to wear the England vest.



The championship will take place in Northern Ireland on 20 June 2026 and will bring together 40 of the strongest backyard ultra athletes from England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland to compete in one of the most demanding formats in endurance sport.

Sarah studied Biology, Chemistry, Psychology A levels and Philosophy and Ethics AS level, going on to study Biomedical Sciences at Cardiff University followed by a Masters in Research in Biosciences and a PhD in brain tumour research at the Brain Tumour Research Centre of Excellence at the University of Plymouth.

Her advice to current Furze Platt students is to work hard at school but also that it is ok to be different; to be kind to yourself, and if you are struggling anywhere, talk to your friends, your teachers, your parents, as they are always there to help.

While selection for England represents a major achievement, competing at the Four Nations Championship comes with significant costs.

# DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DISCLOSURE SCHEME CLARE'S LAW

**IF YOU ARE WORRIED THAT YOU,  
OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW,  
MAY BE AT RISK OF DOMESTIC ABUSE...**

...you can ask the police to check whether their current or ex-partner has a history of abusive or violent behaviour.

This is known as making a 'Right to Ask' request under the Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme (DVDS), also called Clare's Law.

Clare's Law covers all forms of domestic abuse – physical violence, controlling or coercive behaviour, economic or sexual abuse.
