Re: GCSE Results Day – New External Students coming from other schools to FPSS

Dear Year 11 Students, Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well.

I am writing to you regarding GCSE Results Day 2025 and with details of the arrangements for external students holding a conditional offer on how this day will operate at Furze Platt this year, along with information regarding Sixth Form enrolment.

Timings for the day

GCSE Results Day is scheduled for Thursday 21st August 2025. The school will be open for students to come in and enrol from 1pm to 3pm. **Please remember that students must come to FPSS in person to enrol if they wish to study here next academic year.**

Sixth Form Registration

If students are intending to attend the FPSS Sixth Form, they will need to complete their enrolment form online on Admissions+ once they have obtained their results and before they come onto site.

All details on how to enrol can be found at the bottom of this letter. Our entry requirements are published on page 5 and 6 of our Prospectus, which can be found [here](#).

All external students will need to have an enrolment interview. Interviews will be held in rooms E1 – E3, which is on the first floor of our English/Science block. Signs will be out directing students to this area when you arrive at FPSS.

While we will endeavour to accommodate student choice, enrolment on courses will be dependent on timetable compatibility, course availability and students meeting subject entry requirements. Please note there may be waiting lists in place for oversubscribed courses. This may mean we have to confirm final places on certain courses as soon as we are able to after Results Day.

If a student does not meet the entry requirements for a course, we will try to work with them to identify possible alternatives within the Sixth Form. All students must meet the entry requirements for subjects to be considered for a specific course.

Students not able to attend Results Day

Sixth Form registration for external students requires students to register in person as outlined above.

If students are not able to attend school on Results Day to register, they may send someone in on their behalf to do this for them before 3pm on the 21st August, once they have completed their enrolment form and attached their proof of results on Admissions+.

We would expect students to be able to talk to us on the phone, therefore any student representative should bring a working contact number with them so we can call to discuss registration times between 1pm and 3pm.

Students won't be fully enrolled until they have received a confirmation email from Admissions+.

I wish all of you a very enjoyable summer. Don't forget summer coursework is available on the website, [here](#). This will need to be completed by the first lesson in September for each of your subjects.

We look forward to seeing students on Results Day, where we hope very much to celebrate their successes.

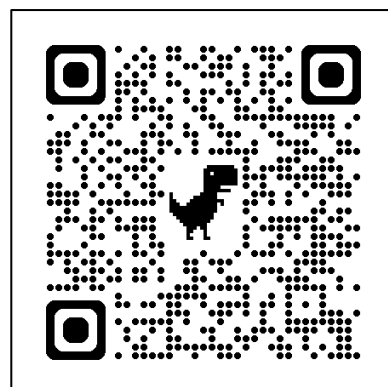
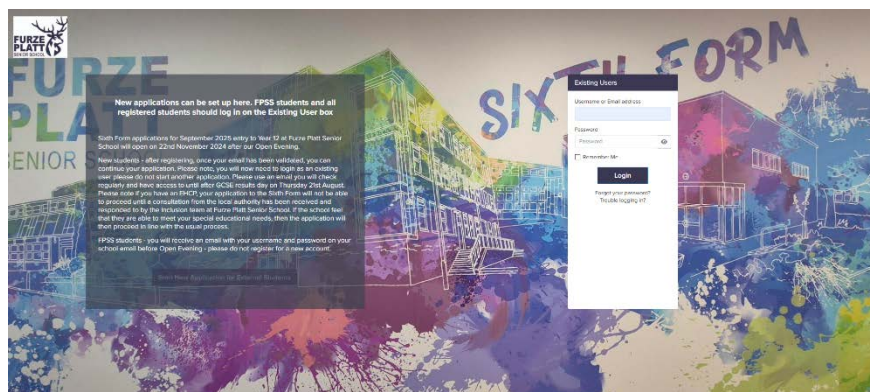

External Student Guide for completing the FPSS Sixth Form Enrolment Form on Admissions+

This document is designed to give students guidance on how to complete their enrolment form on Admissions+.

Please make sure you know your username and password in advance of completing the form as you will need to login to the Admissions+ platform – please use the QR code here:



1. Login to Admission+ **after 10am**. If you have forgotten your password or have trouble logging in, please follow the links.
2. When you login, you will see a notice asking you to start your enrolment. Just click 'enrolment form'.
3. Follow the steps on the form. When prompted, ensure you have changed your grades from 'Predicted' to 'Achieved' and attached the proof of exam results from your school.
4. When you reach the 'Courses' section, read the guidance on this section carefully, scroll down and select the courses that applies to your conditional offer and your results. Click 'Save and Next'.
5. Your conditional offer subjects will appear in the top box unless you have not met your original subject entry requirements. To choose your conditional offer subjects, click 'Finish'. If you would like to modify your course choices, click the 'x' icon on the course you want to remove and select the course you wish to study.
6. Finally, click 'Submit Enrolment Form' in the pop-up window to confirm your choices and submit your application!

Please remember that you will need to have an interview with a member of the Sixth Form team to enrol. Come and talk to us between 1pm and 3pm after you have submitted your enrolment form.
