SIXTH FORM MEXICO EXPEDITION

Sunday 24th July to Monday 8th August

It has been 20 months in the planning but we are finally off to Mexico next week. Needless to say we are all really excited at the prospect of what we will encounter in the two weeks that follow. Activities in the first week include: learning jungle survival skills; day and night-time jungle treks; tracking jaguar and other large mammals as well as trapping and counting numerous insect, bird and bat species. In the second week we will be honing our scubadiving skills; surveying the coral reef system and helping out at a turtle hatchery. Although we anticipate this will be tremendous fun, there is a serious purpose in that we will be collecting valuable data to enable the future protection of these delicate ecosystems including trying to determine the impact of tourism on the coral reef and its inhabitants.






