CHARITY VOLUNTEER MEETS WAYNE ROONEY

Kim Coulson (Year 13) has been working with the charities NSPCC and ChildLine since she was 15. Kim was asked by the NSPCC to meet with and advise Wayne Rooney, England's highest ever goal scorer, who has become the newest Ambassador for Childhood. They spoke about how he could use his following to raise awareness for child abuse and other important issues such as the ChildLine website, and shared their experiences as young ambassadors.

Kim was accepted as a young journalist to write advice columns in the NSPCC young persons' newspaper 'First News' and has been involved in many other projects and opportunities such as running the London 10K, interviewing for senior positions in the organisation, running the charity website, Facebook and Twitter pages, and working with people such as Esther Rantzen as well as sponsors, corporate partners and volunteers.

These are great achievements by a very dedicated student, and we wish Kim all the best with her charity work in the future.




GCSE AND 'A' LEVEL EXAM RESULTS

We are celebrating the excellent examination results achieved this summer. Our A level pass rate was again at 99% for the fourth year running, with 73% of grades at A* - C. We are delighted that Georgia Harris (pictured left) secured 3 A* and 1 A and is taking up a place at Selwyn College Cambridge to study Natural Sciences. There were 27 subjects with 100% pass rates, which is a fantastic result.

Our GCSE results, again very strong, produced a number of first class grades, with Jaspal Mehat (pictured right) gaining an incredible 11A*. 75% of students achieved an A*- C grade in Maths and an outstanding 87% achieved A* - C in English. Our 'value added' score is significantly above national averages.

Students and teachers worked very hard towards these exams and should be justifiably proud of their achievements.

HOME LEARNING ARRANGEMENTS



The home learning timetable for Year 7 is now available. Students will be set two or three home learning tasks per evening. Your child will be given a printed version of the timetable which they will stick in their planners. We use a system called 'Show my homework' to record what home learning has been set. Students also write the details of home learning tasks in their planners. You can access Show my homework through icon (pictured right) on the front page of the school website or on the 'Show my homework' button available at the top of every newsletter.



Then by clicking the Homework Calendar tab at the top of the page. This will display all of the tasks that have been set and you can filter the information by year group, teacher and by class. Later in the term we will issue you with your own log in information so you can automatically see just the tasks set for your child.

We are currently rolling out log in information to your children so this feature will be available to them shortly by using the red log in with Google (pictured below).


