Re: Information - Year 11 Prom Tickets, Graduation and Hoodies

We have a number of very special events to mark the end of Year 11s' compulsory education at Furze Platt Senior School.

Graduation: Wednesday 19th June 2019 at 4pm

Our formal Graduation Ceremony will take place on Wednesday 19th June at 4.00pm, to which you are warmly invited. To help us with planning for numbers please indicate whether you are attending and how many seats you require via your Wisepay account by Friday 24th May. This is a free event.

On the day students should arrive at school by 3.30pm at the latest in order to change into their gowns. They will meet their Head of House in the Humanities block. School uniform should be worn (although it is not necessary to wear a blazer).

Please note, parents should arrive from 3.45pm (not earlier) for the Graduation Ceremony.

On Graduation Day, students will also be expected to return any outstanding text books which belong to the school.

Prom: Thursday 20th June 2019 7pm - 10.30pm

The Year 11 Prom is at Windsor Racecourse on Thursday 20th June 2019 from 7pm - 10.30pm. The event is formal attire. Tickets cost £35 and include a buffet, DJ, photographer and photobooth. There will be no additional costs for photographs on the night but students will need to bring cash for any soft drinks. Students will need a minimum of 1200 positive points to be allowed to purchase a ticket.

Tickets are available to buy via your Wisepay account and will be released as students reach the 1200 positive point threshold. If you have any queries regarding your child's stamp total, please contact their Head of House. If you have any genuine financial difficulties, please do contact Miss Lewis to discuss.
