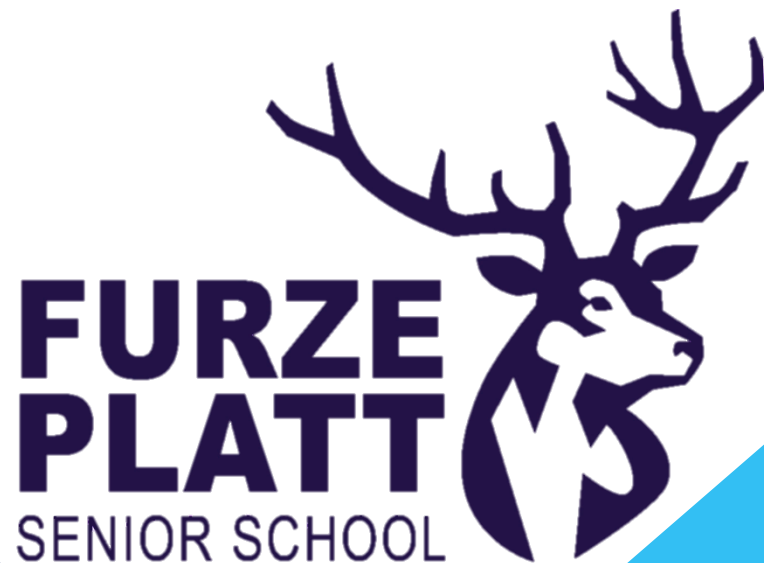
Supporting SEND

- Students with SEND are supported by all members of staff within the school
- Specialised interventions are organised through the Shine team (resource base) or Learning Support Team (mainstream)
- Examples of support on offer include: Reading intervention, Spelling intervention, EAL support, KS3 Raising Achievement, ELSA, Zones of Regulation, In-class LSA support

Supporting SEND

Exam Access Arrangements

- During KS3, teachers will be trialling different exam access arrangements with young people who may need them in their subject.
- There are **no** designated exam access arrangements for any student, even if they had arrangements at primary school. It is up to the teacher's discretion whether to give an arrangement.
- We collect evidence from teachers as to whether this is effective in our setting
- All students will be assessed for exam access arrangements in Year 9. The results of this and feedback from teachers will be used to dictate arrangements for Y10 and Y11.





Revision – 6 top tips

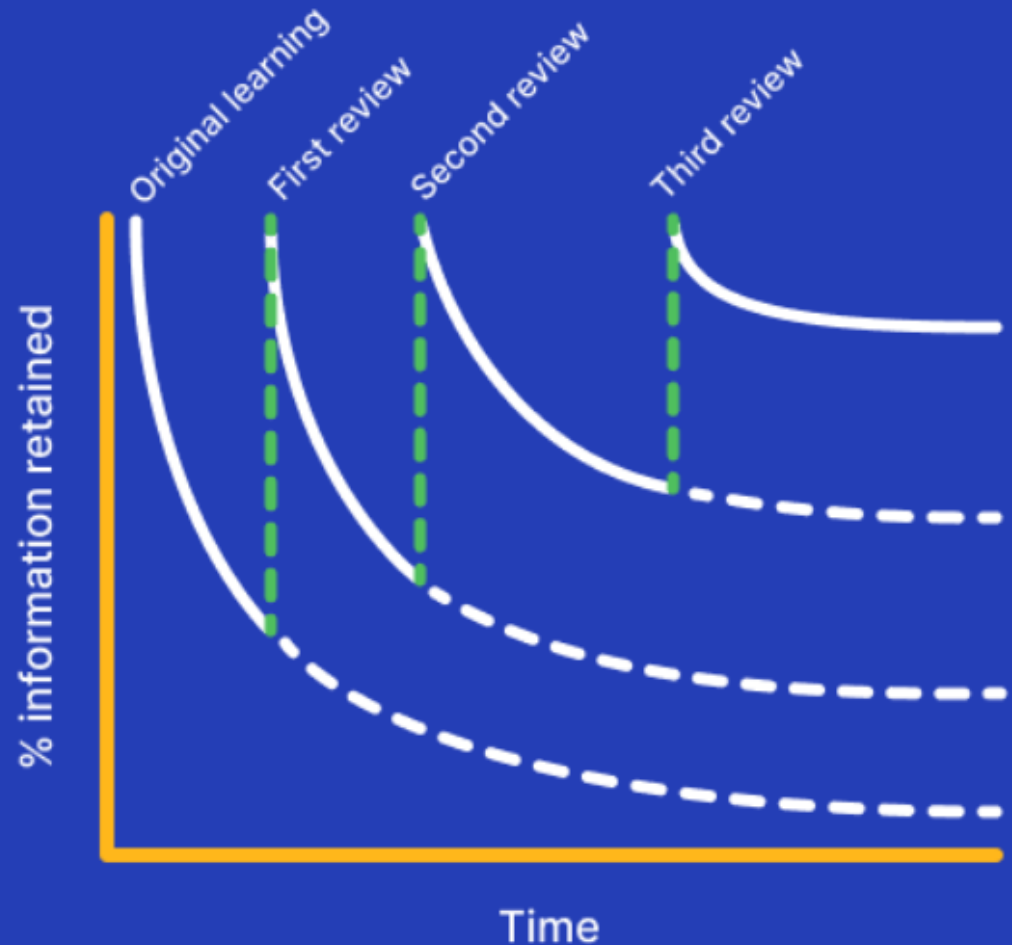
- Targeted short bursts of 30-45 minutes with measurable outcomes.
- Actively distill information using highlighting, note taking, mind maps, rhymes, songs, acronyms and flash cards to boil information down into manageable bite size memorable chunks.
- Test your knowledge and understanding.
- Practice answering exam style questions, especially process driven subjects such as mathematics and science.
- Ask different questions of the same information to examine your understanding.
- Make it fun and memorable.

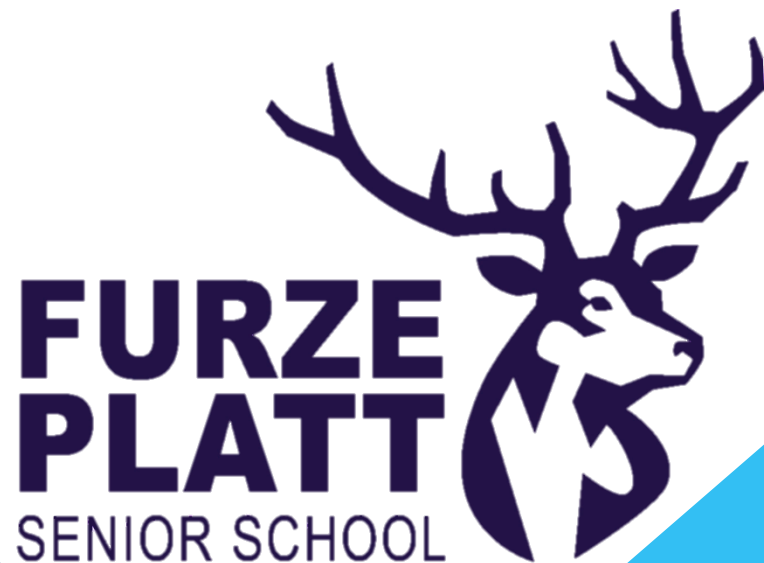
Memory



This is the grade that we believe your child can achieve. We may move this grade up or down to provide the most appropriate level of challenge.

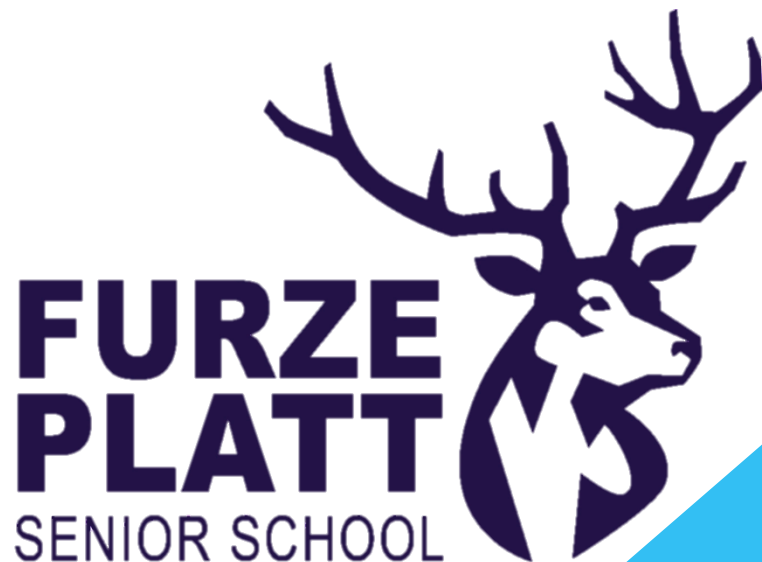
Progress

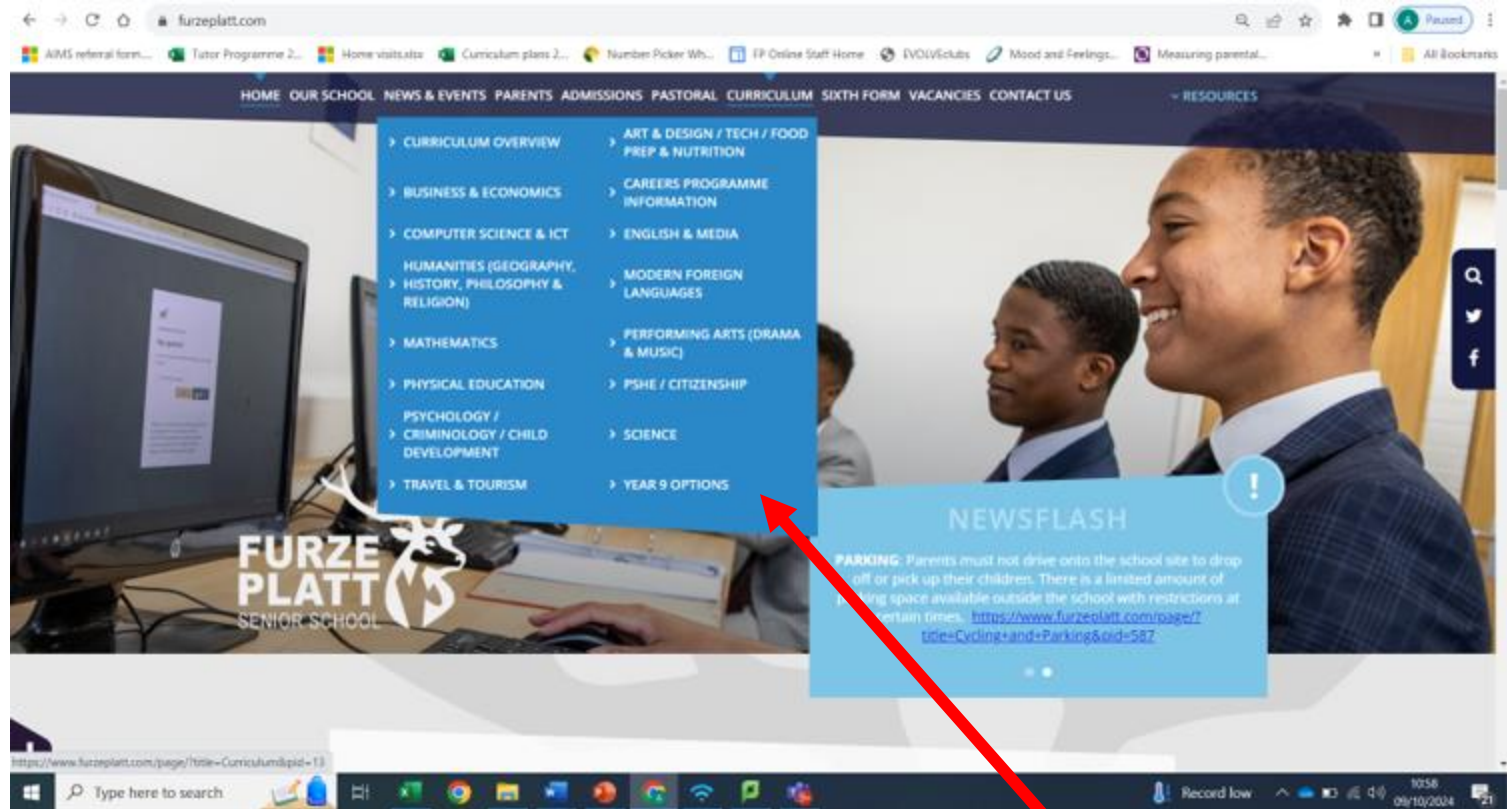

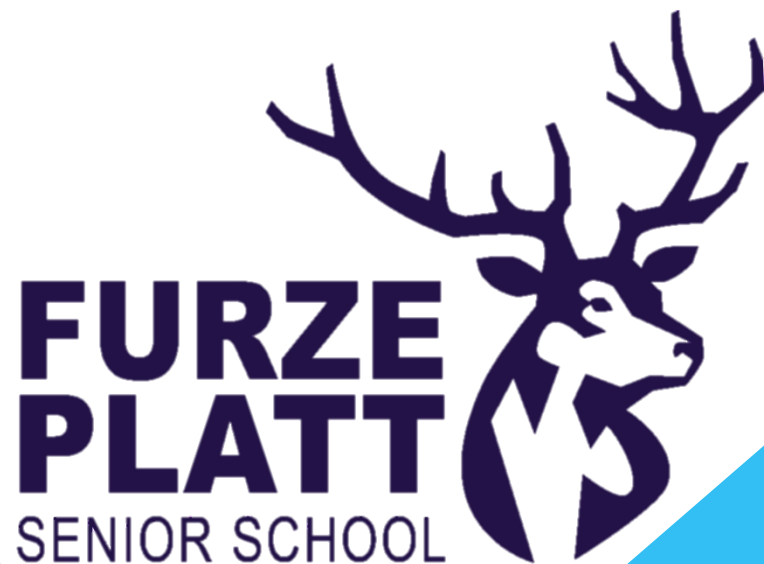


