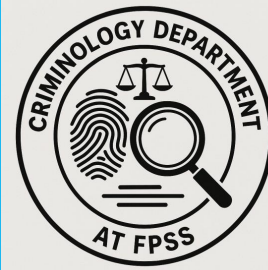

Sarah's Law - campaign

The Sarah's Law campaign was a public campaign to change policy and protect children from sex offenders.

The campaign was a response to the abduction and murder of Sarah Payne, and led to the introduction of the **Child Sex Offender Disclosure Scheme**, also known as **Sarah's Law**

In Unit 1 students learn about how campaigns arise. They cover:

- **How they are represented in the media**
- **They select an aspect of law and create a multi-media campaign to either raise awareness or campaign**

Campaigns that have changed laws (Sarah's Law)



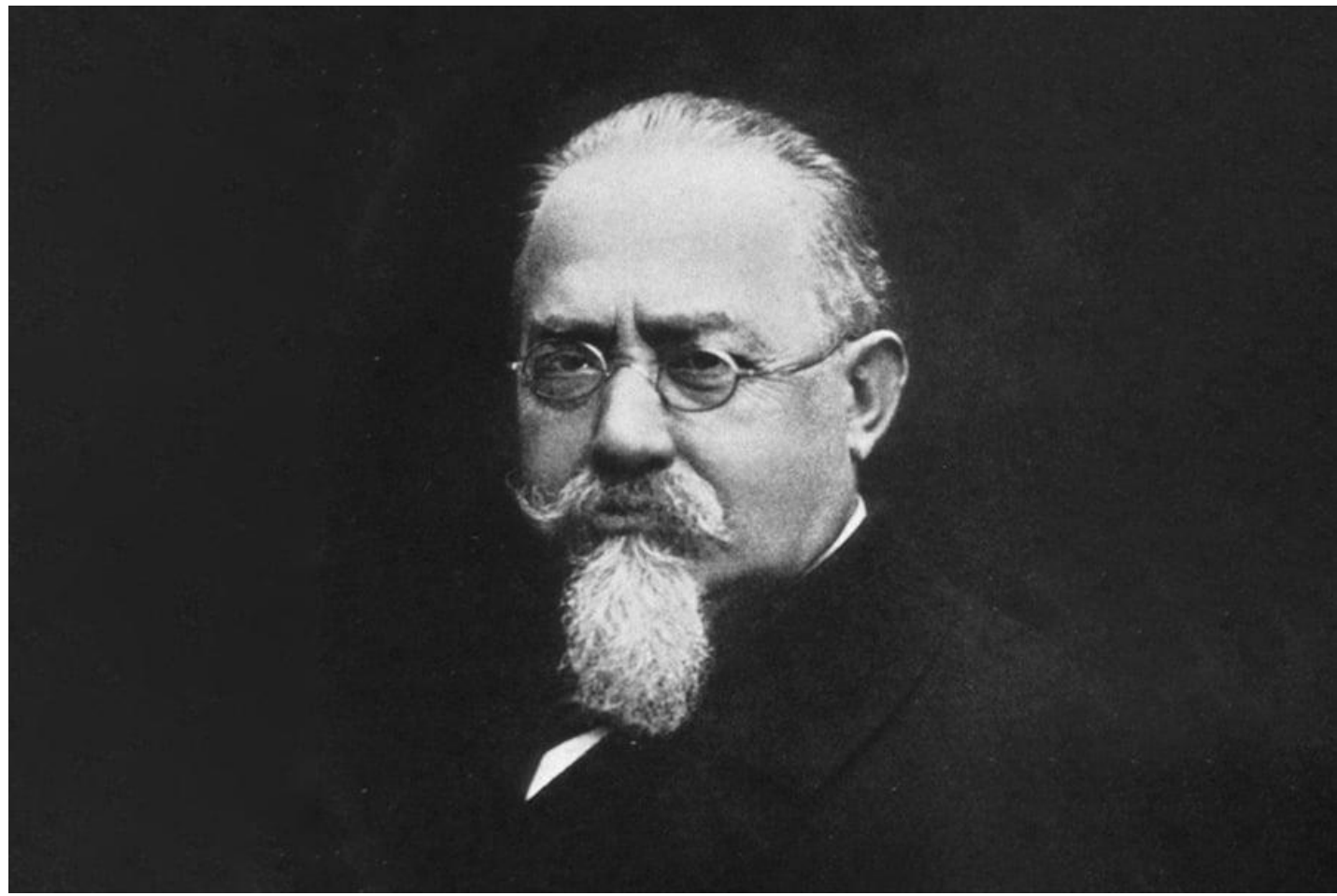

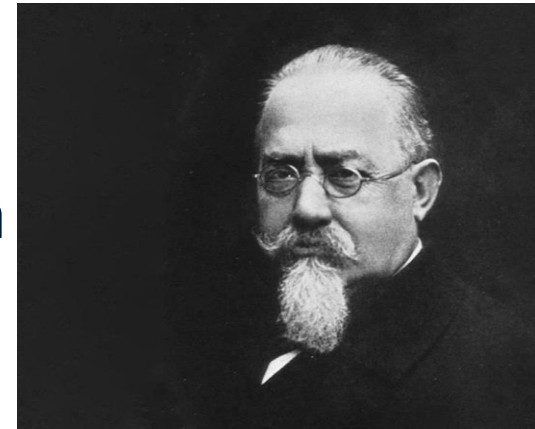

Cesare Lombroso (1835-1909)

He was an Italian physician, anthropologist, and intellectual who is considered the founder of modern criminology.

His theories on crime were based on the idea that criminals were evolutionary throwbacks with physical and mental traits that distinguished them from non-criminals.
