Metacognition- do you know what this is?

It is the awareness and understanding of your own thought process.



Research shows that if you as a learner can understand how you learn, the processes to learning and reflect on your learning and how to improve, you can make up to 8 months more progress. Further reading can be found here:

This is why, in form time we complete reflection tasks and 1-1 coaching conversations so that you are reviewing your own learning. The more depth and thought you put into these, the more impact it will have.

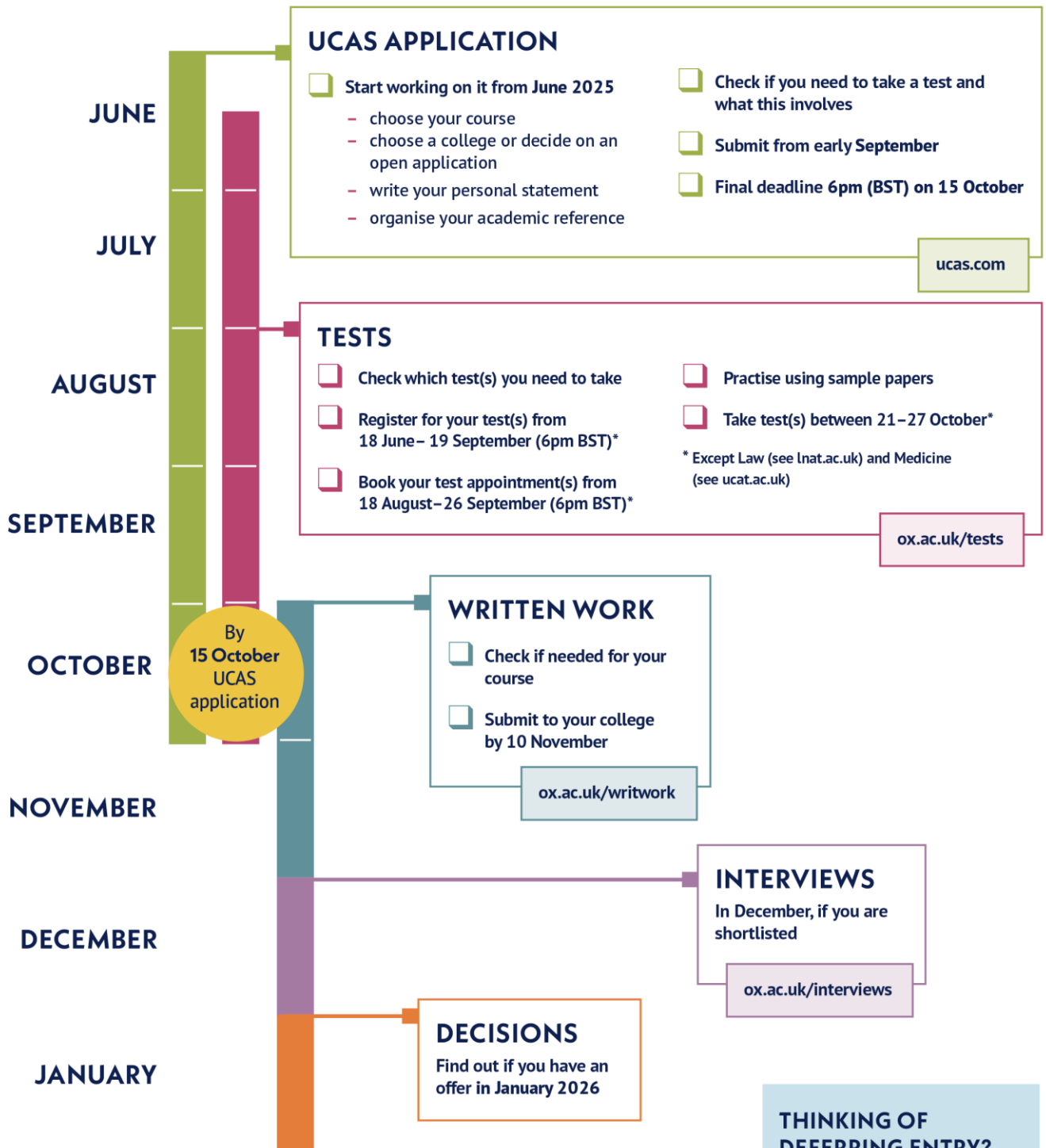
Here are my top tips:

- 1) Speak to your teachers to ensure that you know what is going to be on the PPE.
- 2) Ensure that you have your Specification breakdowns/ relevant PLCs to help guide your revision.
- 3) Download and print some exam questions in advance so that you don't have to waste time looking for them.
- 4) Ensure that you have revision guides/notes etc. ready to use them in your revision. You should be **testing** yourself to ensure knowledge security.
- 5) Remember the rule of 8 – 8hrs of work, 8hrs of sleep, 8hrs of you time.

This is not always possible so we recommend you check with your course department first.

Tutor resource of the week – Pre reading- the BASMO method



Another way of pre-reading is by using the BASMO method:

Browsing- Skim the material to get a grasp of its structure and the key elements

Annotating- making notes in the margins of pages and underlining key portions with a highlighter will help you remember critical details as you read.

Summarising- after pre-reading the text, make a quick summary of its key points

Mapping- map the text to highlight the connections between various ideas and concepts. Are there any links within what is written?

Outlining- arrange the information you gathered from the text in the previous steps into an outline with main ideas and supportive information.
