If there are any Year 12s who would like to join Raise & Give, do let Mrs Beale or Mrs Jennings know.

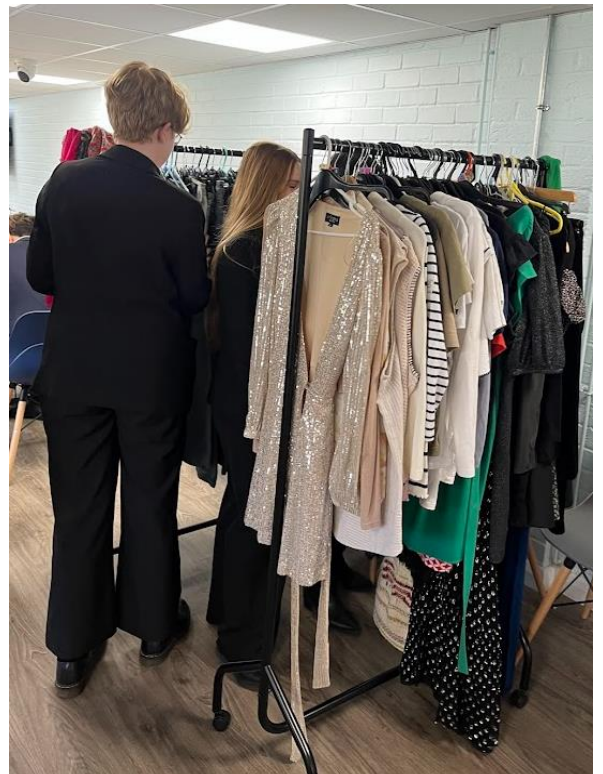
All remaining clothes will go to the Thames Hospice charity shops and hopefully be sold there, so we should be very happy with that.

Remember Sawe, he did not become an elite athlete overnight it was through hard work and perseverance that he got to where he is now.

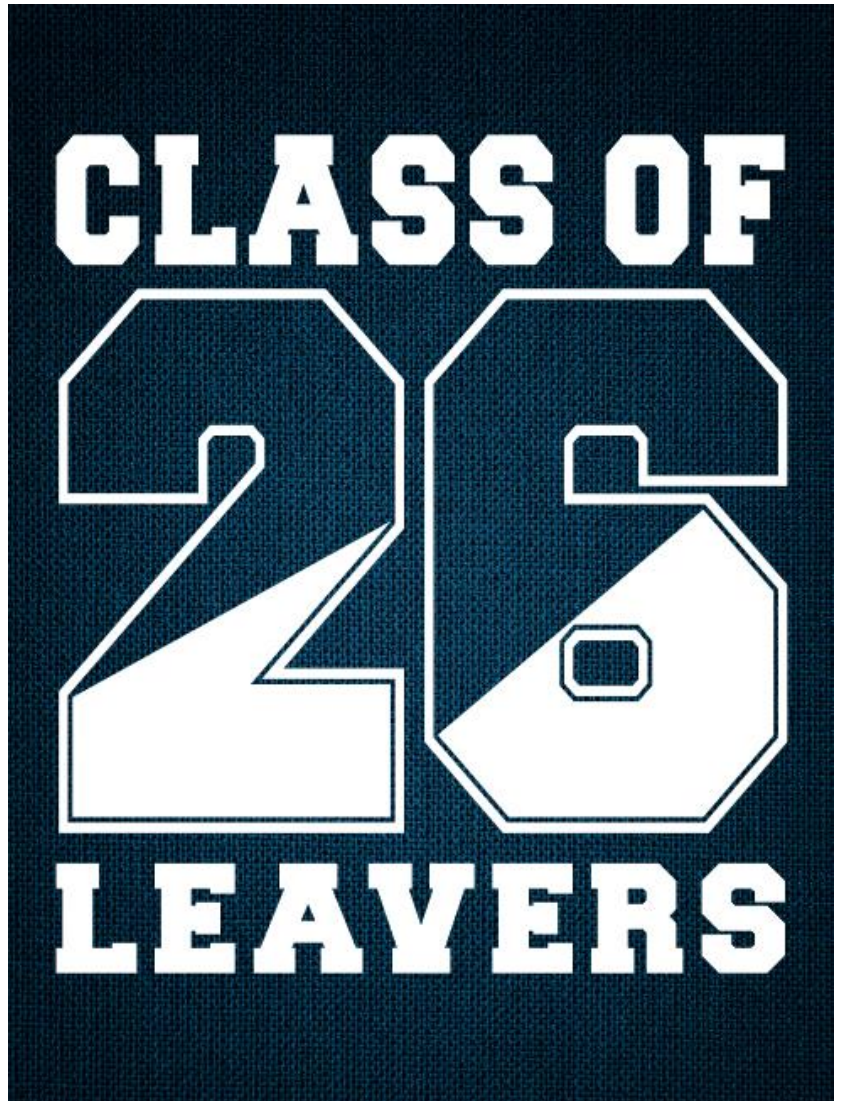
Without putting in the effort outside of your lessons you will find it challenging to get to that finish line this time next year.
