They also raced at Castle Combe Circuit finishing 19th in race 1 and 26th in Race 2.

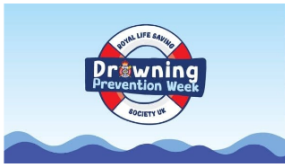

Drowning Prevention Week

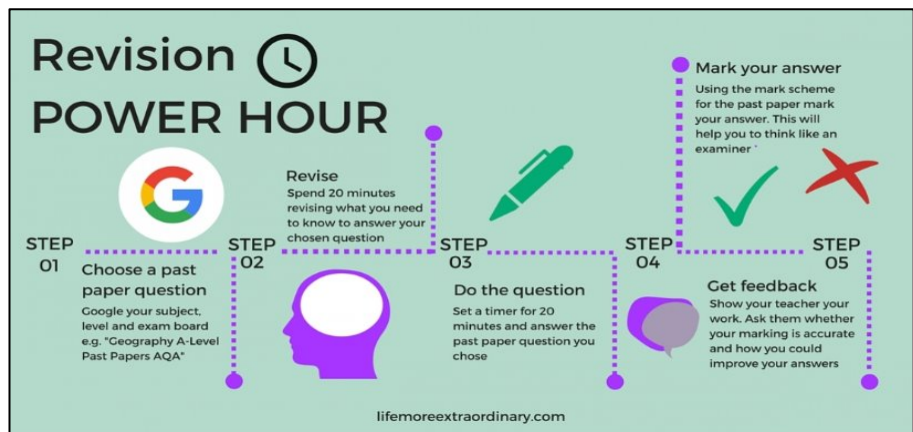
PSHE this week was focused on water safety.

- You are currently in receipt of, or have previously received, free school meals, Pupil Premium, Education Maintenance Allowance and/or 16 to 19 Bursary
- You have been, or are currently, in local authority care
- You are, or have been, a full-time or part-time carer
- You came to the UK as a refugee or asylum seeker
- You are attending a state school or college with:
 - a) below average A-Level or Higher point score and/or
 - b) low rate of progression to higher education([PRIME Work Experience School Eligibility Criteria](#))
- You grew up in a household where the occupation of the main earner is categorised as a routine or manual occupation. For further details please click [here](#)

Note: young people who meet the local authority care criteria do not need to meet any other criteria.
